
A. Large Plot (17' x 3')

Rules

- Community Garden is open seasonally (March 14 October 31, 2025 from dawn to dusk, for renters only.
- Gardeners are responsible for opening and securing gates when they exit with pin number provided.
- A \$20 refundable cleanup deposit is due at registration. It will be returned at the end of the season if you clean out your garden bed by October 31.
- A winter season extension is available to those who have a plot in 2025. The winter season is November 1, 2025 -February 28, 2026. That fee is \$10 + tax and must be paid by October 31. Participants in winter season will not have to clean up their bed until February 28, 2026 and the \$20 refundable cleanup deposit will be kept until the end of the winter season.
- Taking things from garden plots other than your own is considered theft. Report any suspicious or illegal activity in the Garden to Paducah Parks & Recreation or contact the Paducah Police Department at 270-444-8550.
- Pets are not allowed in the garden area.
- Family members are welcome to the garden site. Please supervise young children so they do not disturb other plots.
- Do not climb on the garden walls or on the fences.
- Gardeners are responsible for providing their own seeds, plants, tools, etc. for planting and the general upkeep of their own plot.
- Planting trees and other invasive species are not permitted to be planted in the garden.
- Tall crops such as sunflowers, corn, and trellised plants may be grown but may not shade other plots.
- Perennial plants are prohibited in the community garden.
- Water is available on site for use. Sprinklers are prohibited. Hand watering only. Please conserve water. Please be sure water is turned off when not in use.
- Herbicides (weed killers), insecticides, chemical fertilizers, animal poisons and non-organic materials (including treated wood) are prohibited.
- Plastic mulch or rubber mulch is not permitted.
- Individual garden plots are to be used for growing vegetables and flowers for family use. Growing for commercial sale must be pre-approved by Paducah Parks and Recreation. Other Rules apply.
- Dispose of weeds and garden waste in designated composting areas only.
- Outside food is not permitted for composting or use as mulch.
- Dispose of trash in the appropriate trash receptacles.
- Paducah Parks & Recreation will maintain the center garden circle and shrubs along the perimeter fence. These are additions to the garden for proper pollination.
- Enjoy the season! Enjoy the fellowship! Enjoy the food!
